27–30 April 2015 San Pedro del Pinatar Murcia, Spain



The aim of this symposium is to have some distinguished scientists to give their view on the future developments in phytochemistry in the global era of agri-food and health. The meeting would cover the major aspects of phytochemistry, including allelopathy, chemistry, agriculture, food and health. Young scientists contribute with results from current research through short oral presentations (10 minutes) and posters; ample time will be available for discussions. Senior researchers and professors are also welcome.

Hotel Lodomar has a privileged location, in front of the natural reserve Las Salinas y Arenales de San Pedro del Pinatar, the oldest of the Regional parks of Murcia, and which is a refuge for over one hundred bird species, among which the flamingo is worthy of particular mention, together with unique constructions such as the salt mills. San Pedro del Pinatar is located at the northern end of the Mar Menor (Small sea), a phenomenon that nature designed as a **great coastal lake** of 170 km² of warm saltwater.
